

# List of countries subject to special safety measures

The list of included countries is updated every **Friday**.

The list and requirements of self-isolation come into force on **7th November 00:00**

Prohibition of passenger transportation comes into force on the **third day** after the list is published.

## Significant (very high likelihood) public health threat - international passenger transportation via airports, ports, buses and railway is not provided

\*\*\* Must comply with the requirements in paragraph 56 of the Cabinet's Regulation: if you are in self-isolation and the 14-day cumulative incidence per 100 000 inhabitants of the country, which you have returned from, does not exceed 50 anymore, then you may stop self-isolation.
