




Green Railways are new, mostly non-motorized tourism routes for locals, domestic and foreign visitors regardless of ability and age. The routes are created using old narrow-gauge railway causeways in South-Estonia and North-Latvia. Altogether the routes are ca 750 km long (including original parts of narrow gauge railway lines, re-routing parts, Alūksne-Gulbene narrow-gauge railway and segments of bicycle route "Tour de LatEst").

The tourism routes are available for hiking, cycling, horse - rides or skiing during the winter time.

GOOD TO KNOW:

• The best cycling season is from May to September • Route and route connections (bypasses) are signposted • Bike rentals and service points are mostly in the larger towns, cities • The route passes through picturesque scenes and wide variety of natural objects, beautiful rivers, Gauja National park, North Vidzeme Biosphere Reserve and districts with characteristic heritage.


Gulbene - Alūksne railway is the last daily-operational narrow gauge railway in the Baltics. The small railway with passenger traffic between two district centres has

become a much loved tourist destination, attracting visitors on account of its historical rolling-stock and infrastructure, as well as its heritage value. The small railway is friendly also for those who are riding a bicycle.


